

Guidelines for Applying for Approval for Flying Unman Aerial Systems (Drones) In the Vicinity of The Maurice Bishop International and Lauriston Airport:

- 1- Operators must first apply to the Commissioner of Police to obtain the required permit for the drone operation.

- 2- Additionally, the drone operator is required to contact the NTRC for coordination of the radio frequency protocols.

- 3- Once approval from the COP Office is confirmed, the Operator **Must** contact the Grenada Airports Authority to coordinate the conditions for the operation of the drone around airport in relation to Air Traffic operations, as per the following guidelines:

- The drone operator **MUST** liaise with the MBIA Air Traffic Control Station to get the final authorization/clearance before flying the aerial -drone.
- (Calls should be made no less than half an hour before the commencement time).

NB: Please note the Drones MUST stay out of airport flight paths and restricted airspace areas. Communication with the Air Traffic Control Tower must be maintained at all time.
